The National Redress Scheme (the Scheme) is the government's way of helping our mob who have experienced sexual abuse in places like resi care, schools, churches, sports clubs and other places.

You can get help if:

- You experienced sexual abuse at an institution (like a school, foster care home, camp, sports group, or residential unit),
- the abuse happened before you turned 18,
- you are an Australian Citizen or permanent resident, and
- you will turn 18 before 30 June 2028.



We want you to know, you are not responsible for what happened to you and you are not alone. You can even ask someone from your family, an Auntie or Uncle or friend to walk with you through your journey.
