

Support for young people who have been sexually abused in organisations

The **National Redress Scheme (the Scheme)** is a way for organisations who have joined the Scheme to acknowledge and provide support to people who have experienced institutional child sexual abuse.



You can get help if:

- You experienced sexual abuse at an organisation (like a school, foster care home, camp, sports group, or residential unit),
- the abuse happened before you turned 18,
- you are an Australian Citizen or permanent resident, and
- you will turn 18 before 30 June 2028.

Lots of young people find it hard, but you don't have to do this alone.

Please ensure you get support from a trusted adult to help you.
